Dear Sir:

It has become generally known in the last few days that there have been various public statements on the part of representatives of Chevron Corporation in regards to irregularities that are supposedly occurring in handling proceedings before the Presiding Judge at the Corte Provincial de Sucumbíos [Sucumbíos Provincial Court] in which this corporation is the defendant.

There is an absolute bad faith effort to involve The Ecuadorian State, and the intent is to put it in a bad predicament at the national and international levels; this attitude affects the dignity of Ecuador and that of its Leader, a situation that leads me to ask you with the utmost courtesy to provide certified documentation of the following:

1. An official letter sent to the Office of the Prosecutor General of the State containing factual background and a request for an investigation.
2. Full videos of the conversations that were recorded.
3. Certification concerning the employment relationship of Mr. Diego Borja Sánchez at Chevron Corporation and the period of this relationship.
4. Certification concerning the employment relationship of Mr. Wayne Hansen at Chevron Corporation and the period of this relationship.
