2009 Annual Meeting of Stockholders

At the Annual Meeting of Stockholders on May 27, 2009, the following proposals were voted upon. The vote required and method of counting for each proposal is described in Chevron's 2009 Proxy Statement on pages 3-4. For Item 1, a director nominee was elected if he or she received a majority of the votes cast (i.e. number of shares voted "for" exceeded the number of shares voted "against"); abstentions were not counted. For Items 2-4, the proposal was approved if the number of shares voted "for" exceeded the number of shares voted "against"; abstentions were not counted. For items 5-10, proposals were approved if the number of shares voted "for" exceeded the number shares voted "against"; abstentions and broker non-votes were not counted.
