



### **Chinese Petroleum Company Selects Chevron Lummus Global**

Richmond, CA, December 2006 – Chevron Lummus Global (CLG) was awarded the license for Chinese Petroleum Corporation's (CPC) No. 3 Residuum Desulfurization (RDS) unit at Taoyuan Refinery, located at Taoyuan, Taiwan, Republic of China. The basic design for the unit, scheduled to come on-stream in 2010, is now complete. This 70,000 BPSD RDS plant will increase the low sulfur fuel oil production in Taiwan. CLG is the world's leading licensor of residuum upgrading technology and has two existing RDS units operating at CPC already, at the Talin Refinery, in Kaouhsiung. Their relationship in the hydroprocessing field also extends to the planned ISODEWAXING and ISOFINISHING complex at Talin Refinery to produce superior lubricant base oils.

CLG licenses refining hydroprocessing technologies and catalyst systems worldwide, and is a 50-50 joint venture between Chevron U.S.A. Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Chevron Corporation, and ABB Lummus Global.
