I like to think I have a special appreciation for pressure. I was the first in my family to go to college and now I'm the father of two kids so there's always a motivation to provide. A motivation to do things right.

Pressure is a big calling card for us but with that comes huge responsibilities. On Anchor we're using new technology to safely drill and complete wells at 20,000 pounds per square inch, or PSI, in the deep water Gulf of Mexico.

Embracing that kind of challenge is who we are at Chevron. We thrive on the pressure to push the boundaries of what's technologically possible.

This is a new deepwater benchmark and will help us produce up to 75,000 barrels of oil per day.

As startup manager, my team and I are helping prepare the platform to safely begin operating.

We test every joint on Anchor so our operation teammates can go out and perform their duties knowing that they can operate freely and safely.

At Anchor is definitely individuals from different countries, different languages, but there is singular purpose to converse to exchange ideas and there is a belief collectively we will find the right solutions and persevere.

Once we set this benchmark, I fully expect it to unlock other opportunities for Chevron that goes beyond Anchor. Goes beyond Gulf of Mexico.
