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About

Chevron Appalachia, LLC, headquartered in Coraopolis, Pennsylvania, manages natural gas assets in the Appalachian region, which is home to some of North America's largest and richest sources of natural gas from shale. The Marcellus Shale and Utica Shale are primarily located in southwestern Pennsylvania, eastern Ohio and the West Virginia panhandle.



Chevron is a significant leaseholder in the Marcellus Shale and Utica Shale. In 2016, the company's net daily

production in these areas averaged 290 million cubic feet of natural gas.

Marcellus Shale: In the Marcellus Shale, the company holds approximately 472,000 net acres. During 2016, a total of seven company operated wells were drilled. The company also participated in 12 non-operated wells.

Utica Shale: The company also holds a position in the Utica Shale, with approximately 309,000 net acres. Activity during 2016 included the drilling of one exploration well, which focused on acquiring data necessary for potential future development.

Laurel Mountain Midstream: The company holds non-operating interest in Laurel Mountain Midstream, a company with intrastate and gathering lines servicing the Marcellus Shale area.
