The Permian Basin is one of the most competitive areas in the world for oil and gas development today, and all of our cross functional organizations are continually working to shave seconds off of their piece of the process.

My name is Colter Morgan and I'm a factory coordinator for Chevron in the Permian Basin.

This may not look like a factory, but we're continuously developing well after well after well here in the Permian, and we use that term because it describes the consistent, safe, and repeatable processes that we are going to continue to develop the significant resource base we have here in the Permian.

*We're looking at 21 days of working capability...*

If you boil down my job, the main thing is that I facilitate the development of that well from new construction to drilling to completions to putting that well on production. That includes any problems we may have and mitigating those problems, or ensuring that any efficiencies we may have gained throughout the process, we keep those as it continues to flow through the factory.

In my current role, as opposed to a typical engineering function, I'm involved in field activities all the time. So, I spend sixty percent plus of my time out in the field. One of the most important lessons I've learned is that you can never discount the opinion of the person that's actually looking at the issue right in the face.

So, I actually grew up out here in West Texas. My dad has a small service company that I was raised in, and I was lucky enough to be able to go to the University of Tulsa and study petroleum engineering, and then actually intern with Chevron and then start my career here as well.

We love working out here. We love partnering with the community and with the people out here, because they really understand what oil and gas means to not just this community but to society as a whole. So, I don't think there's a better place to be in our industry.

I think this position's a ton of fun; I never wake up to a boring day. There's always something to do, and in my role, the best day you have is when you solve somebody else's problem. Those are good days for us in Midland and good days for me.
