Chevron's campaign supports public education by helping K-12 educators receive funding for eligible classroom projects through DonorsChoose.org. In 2013, the program supported the education of nearly 1 million students in 16 U.S. communities. In addition, similar Fuel Your School programs were available internationally, in Canada; Johannesburg, South Africa; and Johor and Kedah, Malaysia.

Chevron works with Project Lead The Way to bring a rigorous, projectbased engineering curriculum to more than 100 schools in seven states across the country, reaching more than 80,000 students.

Marcellus Partnership Initiative Pennsylvania, Ohio and West Virginia, United States



Chevron invested more than \$1 million in 2013 to support science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) programs and job training initiatives in its Marcellus operating areas of Pennsylvania, Ohio and West Virginia. We support programs such as the Carnegie Science Center, Project Lead The Way and Mentors Community Wealth Building Initiative.



Chevron invests in the JASON Project, a national nonprofit program that inspires students to pursue careers in STEM fields. JASON uses award-winning, standards-based STEM curricula developed with the National Geographic Society, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, and others. Approximately 100,000 students have benefited from the program in Houston.





Through a partnership spanning more than 25 years with the Honolulu District of the Hawaii State Department of Education, we provide the opportunity for approximately 300 third- through sixth-grade students each year to participate in this noncompetitive, oral communications showcase. Participants are rewarded with both constructive feedback and a medal of participation. Regional Youth Development Initiative El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras and Panama



This program aims to leverage existing resources, partnerships and volunteers to provide complementary educational, sports, enrichment and vocational opportunities that build life skills and promote job readiness for young men and women living in vulnerable communities in El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras and Panama.

11 Speech Competition El Salvador, Guatemala and Honduras

This competition engages talented high school orators in El Salvador, Guatemala and Honduras to spread information on road safety among their peers. Winners secure scholarships to continue their education.



We have developed a visual health program to offer eye exams, eyeglasses and training to residents in the municipality of Riohacha.





We provide microentrepreneurs with a comprehensive training program to create and maintain their businesses and improve their living conditions. In 2013, Chevron supported 1,265 entrepreneurs – 60 percent of them women.





This program focuses on reducing unemployment through vocational training and includes free workshops in computer operations, food handling, horticulture and other trades.







In Brazil, Chevron participates in three projects – Inclusão Comunitária, Com.domínio Digital, and Enter Jovem Plus – to improve opportunities for women and young people by improving their professional skills. In 2013, these programs benefited 900 people.





We're supporting this Texas Children's Hospital program, which supplies doctors to Liberia and Angola to provide maternal and child health care, and train African physicians and nurses.

Women's Entrepreneur Program Liberia

In partnership with the U.S. State Department's African Women's Entrepreneurship Program (AWEP), 750 female farmers and small business owners throughout Liberia have attained business and management training designed specifically for unschooled participants, and three regional food processing centers have been equipped with rice- and cassava-product processing machines. Partnering for an HIV/AIDS-free Africa Nigeria



Through our partnership with Pact, we support the sustainable, communitybased, government-backed PROMOT project to prevent mother-to-child transmission of HIV in Bayelsa State. To date, nearly 7,400 women have been tested for HIV during prenatal care.





Through an economic development program from the Chevron-funded Niger Delta Partnership Initiative (NDPI), fish farmers and other local entrepreneurs participate in workshops and training programs at economic development centers in Warri and Port Harcourt.

20 Cabinda Resource Center Cabinda, Angola

As partners with the Angolan government, we're setting up a business resource center in Cabinda to provide ongoing consulting and mentoring to small and medium-sized businesses to help them improve their productivity and competitiveness.

Fighting Sickle Cell Disease Angola



Since 2011, Chevron has partnered with the Angolan Minister of Health, Baylor College of Medicine and Texas Children's Hospital to create Angola's first comprehensive program to screen and treat newborns for sickle cell disease. More than 65,000 babies have been screened and 900 babies have been treated.





Our Cape Town refinery is working with Northlink College to address the skilled-labor shortage in South Africa by funding training in nationally accredited trade-skills programs.

Empowering Women Through Economic Development Pretoria, South Africa

Chevron partners in an initiative to empower women in rural, disadvantaged communities by combining a microfinance program with an HIVprevention training curriculum.



Chevron supports the Math & Science Incubator Schools program, which uses a unique technology-based learning model to address students' math and science education challenges.





Chevron partners with Telethon Speech and Hearing Centre to offer mobile hearing clinics to service Aboriginal children.





In collaboration with local schools in the Pilbara region, we are enhancing the science curriculum, and with Scitech, our local STEM partner, we have tailored programs for high school students, teachers and remote Aboriginal schools.

Developing Microenterprises Pilbara Region, Western Australia

Chevron partners with Many Rivers Limited to support field offices in the Pilbara region and Perth to help marginalized Aboriginals and other Australians develop microenterprises.

Income for Forestry Communities Darajat, Indonesia



In the forestry community surrounding Chevron's geothermal operations in Darajat, Indonesia, we provide technical training and microloans to help farm laborers start small businesses and conserve natural resources.





Chevron, in partnership with Swisscontact, provides training and coaching on the application of good agricultural and processing practices to coconut farmers and coconut and palm sugar processors in seven villages in Penajam Paser Utara.

Polytechnic Schools Riau and Aceh Provinces, Indonesia



Chevron sponsored and built two polytechnic schools to train Indonesian students for jobs in the industrial sector. Together, these schools have graduated more than 2,000 students.

Walk Wise Program Gaogiao Township, Kai County, China

This program aims to equip students with pedestrian survival skills by presenting a road safety curriculum and awareness-raising activities in schools. Nearly 1.000 students were reached in the 2012 pilot year, and the program has expanded to cover 23.000 more students.



Implemented in partnership with Save the Children, the project aims to increase the quality, availability and access of immunization services and increase knowledge about and demand for immunizations.

Strengthening Community Groups Kazakhstan



By providing resources, training, consultation and other learning opportunities, we help nongovernmental organizations become strong partners in meeting society's needs.

Since 2011, we have promoted healthy pregnancies in Almaty and Astana through information-sharing, training and workshops for pregnant women and medical personnel. In 2014, we've extended the program to medical students.



Chevron helps provide training in social entrepreneurship to specialists working with disabled people. The specialists work with disabled youth, encouraging them to conceive of and implement their own projects.



Constanta County, Romania

Through our support for the Baylor Black Sea Foundation, communities in Constanta County receive infectious disease prevention, testing and care services from a mobile unit and offices in Constanta

Saudi Petroleum Services Polvtechnic Damman, Saudi Arabia

Chevron helped found, organize and direct the Saudi Petroleum Services Polytechnic in Damman, which provides Saudi high school graduates with the technical and vocational skills to become certified oil field supportservices technicians.
